Job Title: Gas Detection Equipment Operator (Start, After 6, 12, 24, 36 and 48 Months)

NATURE AND SCOPE OF THE POSITION

Perform gas detection survey work on mains and services utilizing combustible gas indicators including flame ionization units and other leak detection equipment as may be appropriate.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- 1. Survey mains and services to locate leaks using leak detection equipment as may be appropriate.
- 2. Classify and report leaks according to Company S.O.P.
- 3. Operate appropriate tools and/or work equipment.
- 4. Use curb box locator and pipe locating equipment.
- 5. Clean and replace curb, test and gate box covers.
- 6. Maintain all leak detection records and complete all the paperwork associated with assigned work.
- 7. Obtain natural gas samples for laboratory analysis.
- 8. Perform routine maintenance and service on all gas detection equipment.
- 9. As a Gas Detection Equipment Operator after 48 months, may learn to perform major repairs on all gas detection equipment.
- 10. Performs cathodic protection reads (pipe to soil) using appropriate equipment
- 11. May install service line anodes.
- 12. Performs other duties within the Gas Detection Equipment Operator classification.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Must pass a Company physical examination and must be physically capable of performing strenuous work.
- 2. Must have a mechanical aptitude to work with tools and

equipment. Familiarity with company maps and pipeline facilities is desirable.

- 3. Must be able to communicate effectively with customers and local officials (fire departments, etc).
- 4. Must be willing to work overtime, shifts, and have a good attendance and work record.
