

Tapping/Stoppering Technician "A"

NATURE AND SCOPE OF POSITION

Works as a member of a crew to perform stoppering, tapping, and stopple activities. Performs skilled and semi-skilled duties for the purpose of the installation, maintenance, and repair of the Dominion East Ohio pipeline system.

Typical Duties:

- Works under the direction of a Tapping/Stoppering Specialist.
- Performs various duties related to tapping/stoppering activities.
- Must be familiar with Dominion safety procedures and standard operating procedures (S.O.P.).
- Perform other duties within the classification that the employee previously held.
- Performs routine maintenance on all tools and work equipment, i.e., boom truck, backhoes, tapping/stoppering equipment, safety equipment, etc.
- . Notifies his or her supervisor or Tapping/Stoppering Specialist when unusual conditions are encountered.
- Completes necessary documents (individual paperwork only) within this classification.
- Requisition of materials, tools, and equipment as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Must have been in the Tapping/Stoppering Technician "B" classification twelve months or less and have demonstrated the ability to perform all the functions of the Tapping/Stoppering Technician "B" classification.
- Must have demonstrated the ability to work with others.
- Must possess a working knowledge of all standard fittings and tools.
- Must be willing to travel out of his or her normally assigned work area and work overtime as required.
- Must be able to work shifts and be available for overnight stays when required.
- Must have an acceptable attendance and work record.
- Must have a valid Commercial Drivers License with an air brake endorsement.
