NATURE AND SCOPE OF POSITION

Works as a member of a crew in all duties assigned to the Vacuum Truck. Performs skilled and semi-skilled duties as related to the Vacuum Truck activities.

Typical Duties:

- Operates all Vacuum Truck vehicles and equipment.
- Works under the direction of a Vacuum Truck Specialist or a Vacuum Truck Technician
- Performs various duties related to Vacuum Truck activities.
- Must be familiar with Dominion safety procedures and standard operating procedures (SOP).
- Learns to perform routine maintenance on all tools and equipment.
- Completes necessary documents (individual documentation only) within this classification.
- Performs other duties within the classification that the employee previously held if needed.

Qualifications

- Promotions to Vacuum Truck Fitter Operator "A" classification will be based strictly on qualifications and a recommendation by local management. Employees must have spent a minimum of twelve (12) months in the Vacuum Fitter Operator "B" classification to be considered for a promotion.
- Must demonstrate basic skills in the operation and maintenance of the necessary vehicles, tools and equipment, and safety procedures associated with the Vacuum Truck.
- Must have knowledge and experience with all C&M tools.
- Must have demonstrated the ability to work with others.
- Must possess a working knowledge of all standard fittings and tools.
- Must be willing to travel out of his/her normally assigned work area and work overtime as required.
- Must be able to work shifts.
- Must have an acceptable attendance and work record
- Must have a valid CDL and obtain a tanker endorsement within 30 working days of transferring into a Vacuum Truck classification.
- Must maintain C&M operator qualifications
- Overnight stay may be required.
- Must be reasonably available for emergency call out
