

Vacuum Truck Technician "B"

Contract Rate (Per CBA)

NATURE AND SCOPE OF POSITION

Lead, direct and work as a member of a crew in all duties assigned to the Vacuum Truck. Performs skilled and semi-skilled duties as related to the Vacuum Truck activities.

Typical Duties:

- Works under the direction of a Vacuum Truck Specialist
- May work independently in a lead role in absence of a Vacuum Truck Specialist.
- May operate truck independently in absence of a Specialist.
- Performs various duties related to Vacuum Truck activities.
- Must be familiar with Dominion safety procedures and standard operating procedures (SOP).
- Operate and perform routine maintenance on all tools and equipment.
- Requisition materials, tools and equipment as needed.
- May prepare and maintain all required documentation.
- Performs other duties within the classification that the employee previously held if needed

Qualifications

- Must have satisfactorily performed all the duties associated with the Vacuum Truck-Vac-Truck Fitter Operator A position for one (1) year
- Promotions to Vacuum Truck Technician "B" classification will be based on qualifications and a recommendation by local management.
- Must demonstrate advanced skills in the operation and maintenance of the necessary vehicles, tools and equipment, and safety procedures associated with the Vacuum Truck.
- Must have knowledge and experience with all C&M tools.
- Must have demonstrated the ability to work with others.
- Must possess a working knowledge of all standard fittings and tools.
- Must be willing to travel out of his/her normally assigned work area and work overtime as required.
- Must be able to work shifts.
- Must have an acceptable attendance and work record
- Must have a valid CDL with tanker endorsement..
- Must maintain C&M operator qualifications
- Notifies supervision if unusual conditions are encountered.
- Overnight stay may be required.
- Must be reasonably available for emergency call out
